## **Survey: Minneapolis among best cities to get rich**

The best city in which to build vast personal wealth is -- of all places -- Plano, Texas, according to a recent survey from [Salary.com](http://www.salary.com). But Minneapolis isn't far behind.

Minneapolis ranked No. 4 on Waltham, Mass.-based Salary.com's (Nasdaq: SLRY) "2008 Salary Value Index," which ranked the 69 best and worst cities in which to build personal wealth.

Topping the list was Plano, while the high cost of living in New York placed the city at the bottom of this year's list.

Rounding out the top five cities where it's easiest to get rich include No. 2 Aurora, Colo.; No. 3 Omaha, Neb.; Minneapolis and No. 5 Albuquerque, N.M.

The five worst cities were New York; Washington, D.C.; Los Angeles, Calif.; Honolulu, Hawaii; and San Francisco, Calif.

For its survey, Salary.com compared the value of individual salaries among large cities in the U.S. Local salaries, the cost of living and unemployment rates from cities with 250,000 or more residents were included.
